

## Clinic Coordinator: John F Whitten, II

- Fluently bilingual English and Spanish: reading, writing and speaking.
- o pay is 300 pesos/per hour (approx. \$15 USD/hr) plus benefits (35%) and mileage.
- Annual pay increase tied to CPI (Consumer Price Index)
- Pay Period will be from the 20<sup>th</sup> to the 20<sup>th</sup> of each month, with accountants TeranRojas paying John electronically by end of month.
  - Report hours to Amy Welch, between the 15<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup> of the month.
  - A minimum of 10 hours weekly and not to exceed 20 hours weekly plus mileage.
    - IRS rate 57.5 cents/mile + CPI for Mexico gas. 65 cents/mile in 2020-21, but may be amended for inflation.
- Attend weekly clinics, take pictures, work with vets about any problems; talk to people waiting in line to get their stories
- Verify clinics at least 1 month out
  - Create a WhatsApp group for Clinics: include John Whitten, Policarpo Lopez, Leslie
    Caratachea, Linda Stewart, Angela Kelleher, Clare Leach, Amy Welch, Brischa Borchgrevink,
    Lisa Mahoney.
  - Brischa keeps a phone line current for call-ins requesting info as to where next clinic location and address. 322 113 3955
- Make jpg weekly signs for posting on PEACEAnimals Facebook page
  - send to Amy, Angela, Linda and Brischa
- Keep up Facebook page, answer any questions
  - Angela sends jpg posters to other Animal groups
- Keep track of grant clinic weeks. e.g. \$10,000 USD = 5.5 clinic weeks. Do a write up for donor each clinic week and a summation with pictures at the conclusion.
  - Dec 2-5 write up for Humane Society US (Donna Pease)
  - Dec 9-12 and Dec 16-19 = 2 of 5.5 clinic weeks from Canadian foundation
- o Review Pets for Life contract
  - Suggest changes. Meet with Pres/VP/Secty Treas to review annually in May
- Work with Volunteer Coordinators, Angela Kelleher (PV) and Linda Stewart (Nayarit)
- Take pictures at clinic each week (ideally on Wed)
  - write up 1 paragraph in English and Spanish about where clinic was, how it was unique, etc
  - give this information to Welch for inclusion in newsletter.
  - Give 10 leashes each clinic week to Leslie for distribution to clients
  - Give 10-15 children's PEACEAnimals coloring books each week to Leslie for distribution
  - Count kennels each week.
    - Take pictures of decommissioned kennels
    - Purchase new kennels as needed
- Work out any problems with vets

- e.g. collect receipts for Costco and printing expenses;
- January annual inventory of equipment.
- o Purchase discounted expired dog food at Petco.
  - Make small 10-15 Ziploc bags with 2 cups of kibble and deliver pet food to Volunteer
    Coordinators distribution at clinics
- Purchase as needed:
  - e.g. business cards, PA coloring books, kennels
- Annual Fundraiser
  - Generally, there is one fundraiser only an online auction
  - Collect gift certificates and work with the board to collect
  - Give to Amy Welch to post on <u>www.32auctions.com</u>
  - Work with distribution of items to winners
- Vallarta Adventures
  - Coordinate from Nov to April with Paty Menezes and Ricardo Farkas for 5,000 pesos monthly of medical supplies "Patricia Meneses" <a href="mailto:pmeneses@dolphin-adventure.com">pmeneses@dolphin-adventure.com</a> "Ricardo Farkas" <a href="mailto:rfarkas@vallarta-adventures.com">rfarkas@vallarta-adventures.com</a>
